Thank you for your correspondence of 18 August 2022 to the Minister for Aged Care, the Hon Anika Wells MP, regarding an opportunity to provide input into the Aged Care Workforce: Pre-Jobs Summit Roundtable (Roundtable). The Minister has asked me to reply on her behalf.

The Roundtable was held on 17 August 2022, with more than 20 stakeholders representing universities, unions, advisory councils, providers, community services and advocacy groups attending. Major topics discussed included how to boost job security, making aged care an attractive place to work, access to education and training, the role of migration in aged care and creating innovation in the industry.

The Roundtable provided an opportunity to contribute to the Australian Government's Jobs and Skills Summit (the Summit). The Summit will be held on 1-2 September 2022 and will bring together sector representatives to address economic challenges.
